

Summer Production Manager Description

Hours: Approximately 30 hours during the concert season, including nights and weekends as

needed for concerts and events

Location: Lake Placid, NY and surrounding performance venues in Saranac Lake and Tupper Lake

Position Summary

The Production Manager is responsible for ensuring the smooth and professional execution of all Lake Placid Sinfonietta rehearsals and performances. This includes the transportation, setup, and storage of all orchestra equipment, as well as the management of sound system needs. The position requires strong organizational and communication skills, attention to detail, and the ability to work independently and collaboratively under time-sensitive conditions.

This role involves physical activity such as lifting and moving equipment and requires a valid driver's license.

Schedule Overview

Pre-Season (July 6 – 8):

- Participate in orientation and training as needed
- Organize and inventory equipment
- Review and refine logistics and venue procedures

Season (July 8 - August 16):

- Approximately 30 hours per week
- On call for all rehearsals, concerts, and related events

Post-Season (August 16 – 18):

Assist with equipment storage and inventory

General Responsibilities

- Transport all orchestra equipment to and from rehearsal and concert venues
- Set up and tear down stage equipment (chairs, stands, sound shells, percussion, etc.) for each service
- Store equipment securely between uses or arrange on-site storage as needed
- Operate and monitor basic sound amplification for performances as needed
- Maintain familiarity with venue personnel, access procedures, and site-specific logistics
- Coordinate daily tasks with the Executive Director and conductors

Rehearsal and Performance Responsibilities

- Consult with the conductors prior to each service to confirm setup needs, program order, and any special requirements
- Complete all setup at least 60 minutes before rehearsals and performances
- Remain available or on call throughout all rehearsals and concerts to assist the conductor, musicians, and Executive Director as needed
- Ensure accurate and timely setup of all equipment at each venue
- Collaborate with percussionist to coordinate efficient transitions and adequate setup time
- Supervise stagehands or additional crew in coordination with the Executive Director, when applicable



Qualifications

- Valid driver's license and reliable transportation
- Ability to lift and move equipment (up to approximately 50 lbs)
- Strong organizational and problem-solving skills
- Punctual, dependable, and detail-oriented
- Ability to work flexible hours, including evenings and weekends
- Basic familiarity with sound equipment or willingness to learn

Compensation

Total compensation for this position is \$3,800 for the six-week season.
